NEW U.S. EMBASSY IN BELIZE

On Monday, December 11, 2006, the Embassy of the United States of America, in Belize officially opened. The new Embassy was designed and built as a state-of-the-art facility on a 10-acre site in the capital city of Belmopan. It was designed to fit within the natural setting and to complement the natural beauty of the area. The Embassy recently completed its move to Belmopan from its previous location in Belize City, 50 miles away.

U.S. Ambassador Robert J. Dieter noted, "It is our expectation that this Embassy will become a part of the Belmopan community. The facility offers a

new venue for lectures, exhibits, and other programs that are of interest to all Belizeans".

For many decades, the United States and Belize have enjoyed a strong and friendly relationship. Many Belizeans visit our nation every year and thousands of Belizean-Americans live in the United States. Similarly, thousands of U.S. citizens live in Belize and each year more than 800,000 visit the country. Trade between Belize and the United States is robust, as are U.S. financial and in-kind contributions to Belize's economy and infrastructure. This new Embassy setup represents a \$50 million dollar investment in

Belize's economy. With the opening of the new embassy, new jobs have been created and there are now over 100 additional people working in Belmopan who will have a positive impact on the city's economy and civic life.

The new embassy is located 15 minutes from TAREIG's Camino Del Rio community west of Belmopan on the Western Highway. Service for American citizens is available 24 hours a day. For more information,

San Pedro, located on the Ambergris Cave is the largest island in Belize, and the main destination for travelers to this western Caribbean nation. Ambergris Caye has been the hub of Belizean area maritime trade for centuries. Fishina traditionally has been an historic means of the island's support, but the last thirty years have led to a large growth in both the Belize dive and scuba trade, and ecotourism. The rich variety of things to do in the town of San Pedro makes Ambergris Cave the gateway to Belize.

Experience and enjoy the tranquil beauty of the beach, tropical breezes, rustling palms

and sunset views at the Caribe Island Resort. All of the villas face east affording breathtaking views of the barrier reef and 200 feet of beachfront. Along with the beachfront, the property's amenities include the 300-foot dock, a freshwater pool, bar, restaurant, and beach barbecues. Visits to other cayes, and a variety of snorkel/dive excursions can all be arranged through the front office. PROJECT HIGLIGHT - MODEL HOME CONSTRUCTION BEGINS

The official ground-breaking for the first TAREIG model home has begun at the Camino Del Rio community in central Belize. The first home is a concrete two level Mediterranean style unit with two bedrooms and two full and one half baths, a one-car garage and front and back balcony porches. All of the standard and luxury features will be displayed throughout the home, so that future home purchasers can see the quality and workmanship first-hand. The cabinets and tile work in all units will be custom-made and local products will be used as much as possible. The first model is expected to be complete by early summer and all other new home-construction will be ready to begin by the end of the summer and ready for the busy winter season. Affordable luxury home prices are starting at \$129,000 (USD).

Although most owners will purchase and build homes for second-home or vacation use, a rental pool from which owners may choose to rent their units to travelers to Belize will be available.

GREAT FISHING IN CENTRAL AMERICA

Belize in Central America with the second largest barrier reef in the world, can boast as an angler's paradise. Belize is an ideal destination for fishing because of the varied species and places to catch your prize fish. There are over 30 species of fish to catch and all are within easy reach from many of the country's rivers.

In the local rivers you'll find the giant Silver Tarpon Cruise, ranging 50 to 100 pounds as well as Snook, Jewfish, and Cubera Snapper. The Tarpon and Snook are right at your rod tip in the Caves Branch River system which connects to the Sibun River. The Bonefish weighing 1 to 3 pounds is one of the best fighters Fishing in Belize is the number one pound for pound.

Reef and manarove species include but are not limited to Snapper, Ladyfish, and Barracuda. The Yellowtail Snapper and the Mutton Snapper are the top dinner prizes and feed mainly on Sardines.

Further out beyond the reef awaits the top predators such as Giant Barracuda. Marlin, Wahoo, Tuna, and Giant Grouper. Local charters are available from \$100.00 to \$600.00. There are also

many fishing tournaments held in Belize throughout the year for the amateur and professional.

While river fishing, don't forget to take a moment to enjoy the local wildlife which will keep you company all day. The Howler monkeys will talk to you and play above in the jungle while Iguanas bask in the trees and along the banks. Be sure to bring your camera to also catch some fantastic photo opportunities while you fish the river and lake systems in Belize.
